On Earth, IRAP's researchers, engineers and technicians design tools to understand the constituents of our Universe: stars, planets, small bodies, interstellar gas and dust, galaxies, clusters of galaxies, etc.

These tools include numerical simulation, laboratory experiments, instruments designed to equip large terrestrial observatories as well as space telescopes, rovers and other interplanetary probes.

As we deposit our technology on the surface of Mars, as we orbit closer to the Sun and capture ever more precise images of the near and distant Universe, we are gradually reducing the distances separating us from the objects that fill our sky.
